Mr. Anderson's project management experience includes a variety of projects in Twin Cities area.

Examples of a few select projects include the following:

- *OPUS Headquarters Expansion, Minnetonka* – 10 acre office expansion site pursuing LEED Gold Certification
- *Coon Rapids Business Center* – Construction of a 26 acre retail, office, and hotel development on 14 acres of wetland, within the Coon Creek flood plain.
- *Tamarack Hills II, Woodbury* – Construction of a retail, office, hotel development on a 35 acre site.
- *Xenia Ridge*- 7 acre office and retail development pursuing LEED Gold certification. The site plan includes an 8 story office tower and 6 story parking ramp with a retail/office condominium component in front of the ramp.
- *Riverview Homes* – Construction of a 60-unit condominium building in Minneapolis, MN. This project is located on the Mississippi River, and is redeveloping a former industrial site.
- *University of St. Thomas, Anderson Student Center*- a 3-story student center with an underground garage and large plaza area. The project is pursuing LEED Gold certification.
